**AMENDMENT SPONSORED BY COUNCILOR: Fiebelkorn**

1. On page A-72 of the current 2017 Albuquerque/Bernalillo Comprehensive Plan, amend the following language:

Metropolitan Redevelopment Plans are not established through the Comp Plan ~~[and are not considered policy documents but adopted through a separate ordinance (Part 14-8-4 of ROA 1994). Metropolitan Redevelopment Plans establish policy for the City's Metropolitan Redevelopment Agency to guide catalytic public investments and strategies for economic development.]~~ Information about current Metropolitan Redevelopment Areas and Plans is provided here for informational purposes only.

Explanation: This amendment proposes to make one change:

1. This is to correct an inconsistency found in the 2017 Albuquerque Bernalillo County Comprehensive Plan, where it says that MRA plans are not policy documents at all. The Integrated Development Ordinance (IDO) says that MRA plans are Rank 3 policy documents in which they guide MR projects and funding. Their policies do not apply to land use decisions on private property when the City is not a partner on the project.
